Demographics

The 5th Annual Chicago Lung Run was held on September 12, 2009. The mission of this event is to raise awareness of lung cancer, the leading cancer killer in the U.S., and to raise funds for lung cancer research. Proceeds benefited the Lung Oncologists Group in Chicago (LOGIC), a consortium of Chicago-based oncologists conducting cutting-edge lung cancer research, and lung cancer research through the Respiratory Health Association.

1,704 Total Participants

66% - Female 76% Runners
34% - Male 24% Walkers

51% participated in honor or memory of someone
7% were lung cancer survivors

7% were members of the Chicago Area Runners Association (CARA)

Participants represented 5 states; 90% of participants were from Illinois.
Other countries represented were Canada and Switzerland.
